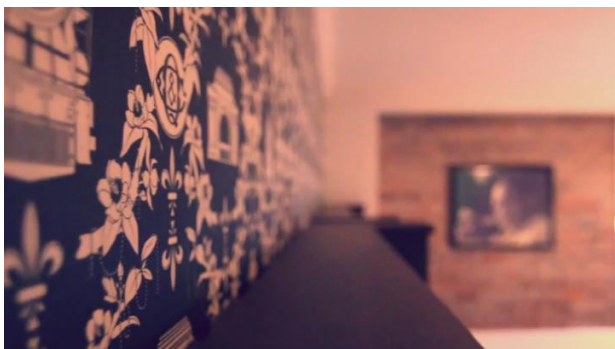
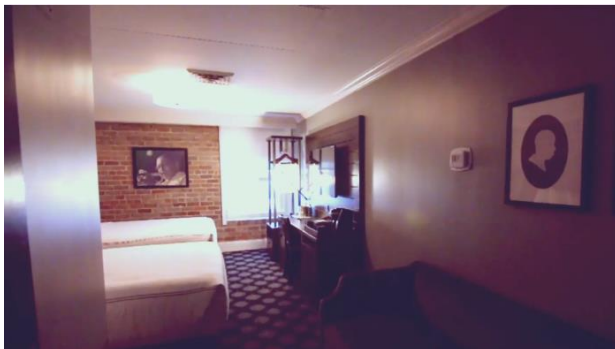


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The Q&C Hotel & Bar is the Most Dope in New Orleans | Video Tour
